

"Miss" Louise was a kind and gracious lady. She and Mr. Sid built the house they lived in a the corner of Barkley Street and Lexington Street in 1924. She enjoyed gardening and her ever present cats. She always had time to visit with the children passing by her yard, listened to tales of their adventures and offered a cold 6 oz. botte of coke on a hour day. "Miss" Louise managed the office of Mr. Sid's Elloree Basarance Agency which was housed in the small building next so Brandenburg Motor Company (now part of the Elloree Heritage Museum building).

WALNUT CRANBERRY SALAD
